

BOWL OUT REGULATIONS

Regulations to be used when a bowl out is required for Senior Cup or Sammy Jeffrey Cup rearranged games.

In the event of a bowl out being required to gain a result in a rearranged cup game the following shall apply.

Five members of each team shall bowl one OVERARM delivery at an unguarded wicket.

Players from each team shall take turns alternately.

The team that puts the wickets down the most times shall be declared the winner.

If the teams are level after 5 players from each side have bowled a sudden death play off shall take place. The SAME bowlers will again bowl in the SAME order until a winner has emerged.

Umpires shall adjudicate on if a delivery is legal. If a No Ball or Wide Ball is delivered it WILL count as a delivery but it cannot in ANY circumstance be regarded as having put down the wicket.

The umpires shall approve the balls to be used. (Balls do not have to be new but must meet league specifications)

If the match had started but no result had been possible the players taking part in the bowl out MUST be selected from each teams playing

If no play had taken place the five bowlers may be selected from any eligible players registered to the club (Starred, cup tied players will be classed as ineligible.)

No player shall be permitted to stand in front of or behind the target wicket. A player will however be permitted to stand back from the stumps so as to field the ball.

A player who takes part in a bowl out will not be classed as cup tied for a lower grade competition
